Courtesy, respect, good manners and consideration for others, together with self-discipline, are important aspects of a child's education. The school has few school guidelines and most of them relate to health, safety and wellbeing:

- 1. In school children always walk, and enter and leave the building sensibly.
- 2. Children inform the teacher or another adult whenever they leave the classroom.
- 3. Children wear no jewelry in school other than a single small ear stud in each ear.
- 4. All clothing to be marked with the child's name.
- 5. Toys are not brought in to the school as it can take no responsibility for loss or damage.
- 6. Only fruit or vegetables may be brought into school to eat at morning playtime, but no sweets, chocolate or crisps.
- 7. Bikes or scooters are to be pushed to and from the school gate and may not be ridden on the front playground.
- 8. Children may not go on the grass at the front of school, nor on The Sandlings Garden.

What is a home-school agreement?

A home-school agreement explains the aims and values of your child's school. It spells out the responsibilities of both the school and the parents, together with the school's expectations of its pupils.



Why are home-school agreements important?

Children achieve more when schools and parents work together. A home-school agreement helps you to work with your child's school. Your support and encouragement are very important if your child is to make the most of school.

As A School We Will:

- Create an atmosphere where each child is valued, encouraged to do their best, taught to take care of themselves and property and become a caring member of the community.
- Provide a balanced curriculum that meets the individual needs of every child and encourage them to reach their full potential.
- Provide learning activities that are appropriate and manageable for each individual child; including targets for each pupil that support further progress.
- Have high expectations of good behaviour and expect all school guidelines to be followed.
- Monitor absences and talk to parents/carers if there is a problem with attendance or punctuality.
- Inform parents and children of the equipment required for participation in all school activities.
- Encourage children to be suitably dressed for school and to take a pride in their appearance.
- Keep parents regularly informed of their child's progress - formally and informally - be open and welcoming at all times, and offer opportunities for parents to become involved in the daily life of the school.
- Endeavour to respond to all email and telephone requests within 24 hours and on the day a request is made, where possible.

As A Child I Will Try To:

- Enjoy my time at school, be kind to everyone, work hard in lesson times and take pride in all I do.
- Do all my class work with enthusiasm and as well as I can and tell an adult if I am worried about something.
- Do my homework with care, and talk to my parents about my work and how I am behaving at school.
- Be aware of learning at home as well as at school.
- Take care of my surroundings and belongings, be polite and helpful to others and keep the school rules.
- Come to school every day on time unless I am ill.
- Make sure I have all the equipment I need every day including my reading or spelling book, violin, homework and PE kit.
- Take care of my school clothes and be neat, clean and tidy.
- Talk to my teachers if I cannot understand something and tell them and my parents how I am getting on.

As A Parent/Carer I Will Try To:

- Talk and listen to my child, encourage them to work hard, treat all members of the school community with respect and courtesy, and support the school behaviour policy.
- Encourage my child in all aspects of learning, give praise as appropriate, and look for opportunities outside school to extend their knowledge and understanding.
- Encourage my child to complete all homework set, and give them all the support I can.
- Ensure the school is made aware of any special needs my child may have, and support the school rules.
- Ensure my child arrives at school on time with all the equipment they need.
- Take my annual holiday in school holiday times.
- Ensure my child has appropriate, clearly named clothing for school and is clean and tidy in appearance.
- Take an interest in my child's progress, attend parents' evenings regularly and support school events whenever possible.
- Talk to the school directly if I have any concerns and not use social media to air them.
